## **Details:**

### **Applicant Qualification:**

You must be under 30 and an undergraduate or graduate student studying architecture or, a young architect. You must be registered for UIA2011 TOKYO before you may apply for 'Youth Jamboree'. You cannot have any accompanying person.

### **Enrollment Limit:**

120 students and 40 young architects

**Team Organization:**

16 teams of 10 people

One tutor will be assigned to every two teams.

**Works:**

Teams may use models, images and sketches in their proposals. In addition, while the rights of authorship of materials prepared during the conference reside with the participants, the right to present and publish the materials will reside with the organizer.

**Language:**

Work, presentations and reviews will be taken place in English.
