GINZA, its front and back: Ginza is said to be the most expensive land in the world.



There are so many latest modern fashion buildings in the area. At the same time, there still remain old back alleys where “oinari-san” (a traditional community shrine) quietly stands.

Bridges of Chuo-ku: Just a few decades ago, Chuo-ku was full of canals. Many bridges still remain.



TSUKUJI, the alleys: Tsukiji is now the world famous fish market. The surrounding area called “jougai” is as interesting as the market itself.
