Tour Highlights: Let's slip back in time to the Edo period where you can learn the modern model of ecological city! The city of Edo (which is Tokyo today) had developed as drastically as London and Paris, and had become the most advanced city in the world by the early 18th century.

Sensoji Temple: Main Hall, Five-story pagoda, Kaminarimon Gate, Hozomon, Sensoji, located in the central area of Asakusa, is the oldest Buddhist temple, and had been worship by the local people of Edo period. Today, the temple attracts many tourists from all over the world throughout the year.

Tokyo Sky Tree: Currently under construction in Sumida-ku and scheduled for completion in the spring of 2012. Its height designed to be 634m upon completion, the Tokyo Sky Tree will become the tallest broadcasting tower in the world. The Second Observatory is glass-covered and the Air Corridor offers opportunity to the visitors to experience sensation as if they are walking in the air. The architect will prepare the guidance of design.

Fukagawa Edo Museum: At Fukagawa Edo Museum, the Edo period street has been reproduced and you can experience life in an old Edo machiya so that you could learn the modern model of ecological city.

Kiyosumi teien: This park is a typical "KAIYUU STYLE" Daimyou garden in Edo period. The park features a pond, artificially placed hills and rocks. We'll have a TEA at the SUZUMITEI, enjoying the view of the pond.

Matsuya: "EDO KARAKAMI" is used for sliding walls and as interior finishing material. It has beautiful wood-block printing on "Washi" featuring traditional Japanese-style patterns
